

M I N U T E S O F B.T.T.U. CONGRESS

Hold in Belgrade, on 26.of March 2007, at 19:00 in Beograd Arena (during European Championships)

1. President welcome and opening remarks

President of BTTU, Oktay Cimen, welcomed all delegates.

President of Table Tennis Association of Serbia Aleksandar Matkovic welcomed all participants to Belgrade.

With great sadness all delegates were informed about the death of Yoto Drianovski. In his honor all members of BTTU observed the minute of silence. Congress awarded the title of Historical Honorary Member of BTTU to Yoto Drianovski.

2.Roll Call

A total number *of* 7 country members associations were present: Bosnia and Herzegovina. Bulgaria. Greece. Montenegro, Romania, Serbia and Turkey. List of presented delegates is enclosed.

3. Approval of minutes of previous Congress (Patras, GRE, 02.09.2006)

After the bad news of our friend Yoto, minutes of Congress in Patras was prepared from Georgios Seliniotakis.

The minutes of previous Congress in Patras were signed by the Chairman of Congress, on behalf of the head of delegation, as a true record.

4. Appointed of Gen era I Secretary of B TTU

Congress accepted the proposal of Georgios Seliniotakis to appoint Milorad Trpkovski (SRB) for General Secretary of BTTU. At same time it was decided that the office of BTTU will be in Belgrade.General Secretary of Bulgarian Federation. Misha Froloshki, delivered sum, in cash, of EURO 3.285 to new General Secretary', Milorad Trpkovski. This amount was given to Bulgarian Federation, by Wan Drianovski son of Yoto, who has taken it from Bank, after Yoto death.

New Account of BTTU will be opened in Belgrade and above amount will be paid.
