**OF EXTRAORDINARY BTTU CONGRESS 2010.**

**hold in Subotica on 20<sup>th</sup> Novembrer 2010.**

BTTU General Secretary Trpkovski regarded all delegates and expressed complacency because at this meeting attend ETTU Vice President, MATKOVIC Aleksandar and BTTU Honorary member Mr. OSMANAGIC Dusan.

Trpkovski, informed all delegates that this BTTU Congress is not annual, as it was written in materials, than extraordinary Congress, because the Turkish Federation accept to organize Senior Balkan Table Tennis Championships in Bursa, from 16. to 20. December this year. It means that Annual BTTU Congress will be during the Balkan Senior Table Tennis Championships. Also, according our Handbook President of BTTU is Mr. Cimen Oktay. Mr. Trpkovski asked Mr Cimen to lead this meeting.

**1. President welcome and opening remarks**

President of BTTU CIMEN Oktay, welcomed all delegates and thanked for coming in Subotica. He asked President of Serbian Table Tennis Association, Mr. Kalinic Zoran to welcome the delegates.

Mr. Kalinic expressed special thanks to all delegates for coming in Subotica. As at the same time Serbian Association organized European Mixed Double Championships and Serbian Open '010 he invited all delegates to stay in Subotica and to be guest all time during the those Championships.

Mr. Trpkovski Milorad presented secretary's general report. The report was accepted as presented, including the financial report.

### **5. Delegates' reports- 18<sup>th</sup> Balkan Youth Table Tennis Championships in Slatina (ROU), 24<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> June 2010**

Mr. Borislav Pejakovic, Technical Delegate at the 18<sup>th</sup> Balkan Youth Table Tennis Championships in Slatina, Romania, from 24<sup>th</sup> - 27<sup>th</sup> 2010. presented their reports of BYTTC.

This report was accepted as presented.

### **6. Proposals for the BTTU Handbook**

BTTU General Secretary explain that he trysted this meeting because we have serious problem to organize our competitions.

First, at the beginning of this year we couldn't find organizer for Senior and Youth TOP 16, the competitions which we introduced last year, at BTTU Congress in Bursa.

Then Kragujevac canceled the organization of BTTU Senior (U21) Championships.

During the Balkan Youth Table Tennis Championships in Slatina, in June this year, Romania accepted to organize SBTTC in Busau in October 2010. Unfortunately due to economic crisis and break down of sponsors Busau canceled these Championships.

Therefore we must do something. Probably we have to change something in our Regulations.

Maybe the solution is that every Associations pay some sum for hospitality for players?

ETTU Vicepresident Matkovic regarded all delegates on behalf of ETTU and wished success of this Congress. In his opinion the paying of 20-30 Euro for hospitality is necessary for covered of expenses of organizer. Also, he considered that BTTU have to change in Handbook that President would be elected at period of 2 or 4 years and to work with General Secretary in close cooperation. Maybe the solution is to have BTTU Board of Directors. He promised that he would try that ETTU form Solidarity fond to help BTTU.

BTTU Honorary member, Mr. Osmanagic said that the fact is that mainly, in last period, Turkish, Romania and Serbia was organizer of BTTU Championships. Therefore we have to introduce the row for organization of every BTTU Associatins. Also we have a lot competitions. Therefore we must organize only the our official Championships (senior and youth).

Delegate of Montenegro, Rogic is agreed that some sum would be payed for hospitality for BTTU competitions. But he put remark that sum for hospitality for ETTU and ITTF competitions are too expensive.

Delegate of Romania, Filimon was agreed with that and said that hospitality for Open Championships, of 60,70,80 Euro are also high.

Matkovic explain that it is the Rules of ETTU and repeated that settlement is Solidarity fond.

BTTU President, Cimen sugested to invite ETTU President Bosi to our Congress to hear problems of hospitality for ETTU competitions.

As BTTU Annual Congress would be organized in Bursa next mount it was agreed that all Association send they proposal about new organization of BTTU competitions. Technical Committee in cooperation with BTTU General Secretary would joined propositions.
